Telehealth Coverage

Get started using your Telehealth benefits. Telehealth can help you and your families utilize your health benefits and avoid a trip to a medical office.

The Ironworkers District Council of New England Welfare Fund has established a telehealth solution powered by Teladoc through Tufts Health Plan. With telehealth from Teladoc, members can access U.S.-based, board-certified providers for general medical needs and diagnoses from anywhere in the world for \$0 copay. Members can contact a Teladoc doctor 24/7 if they're concerned about their symptoms or have questions about Coronavirus, as well as any other medical related issues.

To access your telehealth benefits for Behavioral Health you should contact Modern Assistance Program at 671-774-0331. Telehealth copay visits through MAP are \$0 copay for Covid-19 related visits and a \$5 copay for other telehealth visits.

Your current providers may offer telehealth services, ask your primary care provider or any other provider you prefer to use, if they do. All out-of-pocket costs for telehealth visits related to Coronavirus will be waived for the duration of this COVID-19 situation and the copay for other illnesses will be \$20.
